



Ulceby Parish Council Young Achievers Award 2009

Ulceby Parish Council has created a new **Young Achievers Award** to help celebrate the accomplishments of younger members of our society.

Eligible youngsters between 6 – 17 years old can be nominated for consideration of a Certificate of Achievement and a small gift voucher. Candidates must reside in Ulceby Parish and may only be nominated by any resident who is himself or herself resident in the Parish.

The Awards can cover achievements in many areas, including:

- Community work or public-spirited actions
- Caring Duties
- Overcoming a personal disadvantage
- Charity or fundraising work
- Excellence in arts, sports or similar activities. (Academic achievements are not eligible unless they involved overcoming e.g. some element of personal disadvantage.)

The eligible Age Groups (age as at **30th September 2009**) are
Group 1: Age 6 – 10. Group 2: Age 11 – 14. Group 3: Age 15 – 17

All nominations will be considered for a Bronze, Silver or Gold Award, and as well as receiving a Certificate of Achievement, we will also award gift vouchers of £10, £15 or £20.

The deadline for Nominations is 30th September 2009.
