### **PUBLIC FORUM**

Four members of The Public.

The Chairman sought permission from the meeting to suspend standing order to allow members of the public to take part in the discussion relating to the revised bus services – unanimously agreed.

#### **1. MR D HEWITT – REVISED BUS SERVICE FOR ULCEBY.**

The Chairman welcomed Mr Hewitt to the meeting. Mr Hewitt gave an outline to why the bus service has had to be reviewed – namely because Stagecoach advised that all their services running to and from Ulceby were operating at a loss. N.L.C endeavour to provide an adequate service for Ulceby – with emphasis on services available for people getting to and from work – hence the predominantly early services. The bus services provided for Ulceby at the present moment in time are subsidised by N.L.C.

The meeting asked if the Villager Service which operates regularly for Goxhill residents could be extended to provide a better service for Ulceby residents. Unfortunately Mr Hewitt could not offer an extension to the Villager Service as the time involved to travel to Ulceby would throw the bus schedule out and be unsuccessful for all concerned. Mr Hewitt was sympathetic to the needs of the residents of Ulceby and appreciated that the current level of service is far from satisfactory but could not promise a better service in the near future.

Mr Hewitt did agree to look into the possibility of getting the bus to pick up at bus stops along Station Road – rather than expect residents to walk all the way down to the Post Office.

The Chairman thanked Mr Hewitt and members of the public for attending the meeting.
